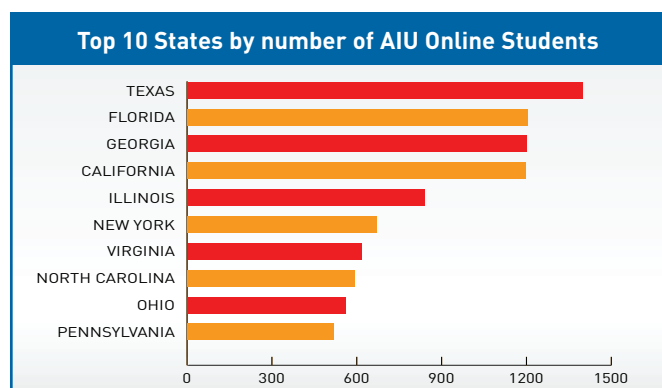

Student Satisfaction with AIU Online

96% have the needed Information Technology skills

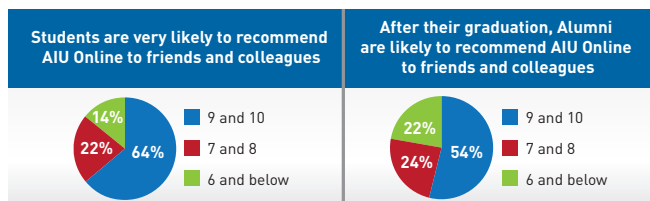
96% have a practical understanding of group dynamics and teamwork

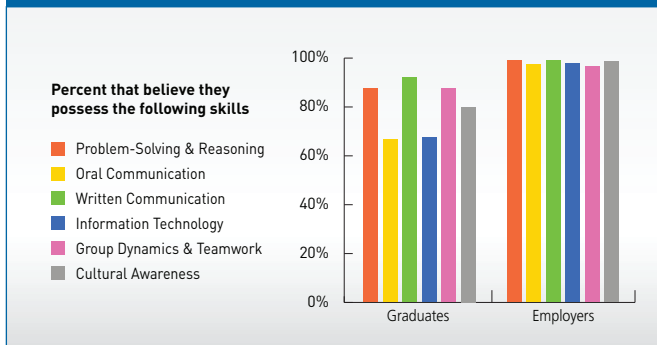

Please note: The employer's survey is sent a month after graduation to give the graduates time to get an employer – which is why there is a month separation.

Online education is growing in popularity

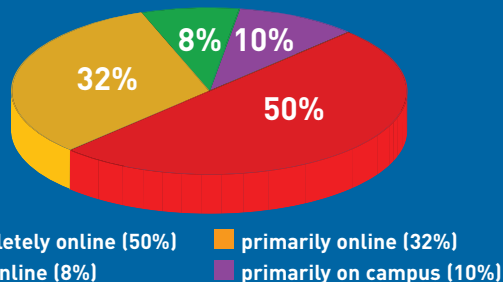
By 2006 nearly 3.2 million college students were enrolled in at least one online course – up from 1.6 million in 2003.*

By 2008, 1 in 10 college students will be enrolled in an online university.**

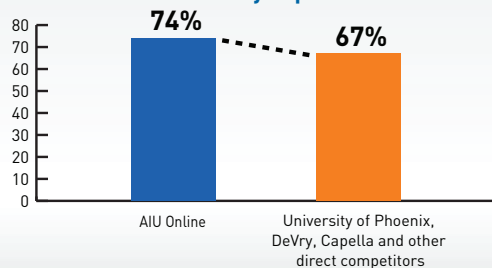

AIU Online surpasses our competitors in the services we provide

In our quest to demonstrate the quality of our education, we recently partnered with Noel-Levitz to see how we compare against some of our direct competitors who also took the survey, namely the University of Phoenix, DeVry, Capella, several Kaplan schools, and several others. 74% of AIU Online students replied that so far their college experience has been better than they expected, compared to only 67% of our peer group. Additionally, 90% of AIU Online students are satisfied with their experience so far, compared to 87% of our peer group.
